



## NATIONAL NUCLEAR REGULATOR

*For the protection of persons, property and the environment against nuclear damage.*

### INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS TO SERVE AS CHAIRPERSON OF THE PELINDABA PUBLIC SAFETY INFORMATION FORUM (PSIF)

The National Nuclear Regulator (NNR) is an independent regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Nuclear Regulator Act (Act No. 47 of 1999) to regulate the use of nuclear energy and materials to protect health, safety, security and the environment from nuclear damage in South Africa. In terms of the National Nuclear Regulator Act, the NNR's regulatory mandate involves the following priority areas;

- (a) provide for the protection of persons, property and the environment against nuclear damage through the establishment of safety standards and regulatory practices;
- (b) exercise regulatory control related to safety over—
  - (i) the siting, design, construction, operation, manufacture of component parts, and decontamination, decommissioning and closure of nuclear installations; and
  - (ii) vessels propelled by nuclear power or having radioactive material on board which is capable of causing nuclear damage, through the granting of nuclear authorisations;
- (c) exercise regulatory control over other actions, to which this Act applies, through the granting of nuclear authorisations;
- (d) provide assurance of compliance with the conditions of nuclear authorisations through the implementation of a system of compliance inspections;
- (e) fulfil national obligations in respect of international legal instruments concerning nuclear safety; and
- (f) ensure that provisions for nuclear emergency planning are in place.

The South African Nuclear Energy Corporation (Necsa), as holder of nuclear authorisations for the nuclear facilities on the Necsa Pelindaba site, is required as per Licence Condition 26 and the provisions of Section 26(4) of the National Nuclear Regulator Act to establish a Public Safety Information Forum (PSIF), to inform the persons living in the municipal area in respect of which an emergency plan has been established on nuclear and radiation safety information related to the nuclear installations.

A further provision in accordance with Regulation R968 of 12 September 2008, is for the PSIF to have a Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson who shall be appointed by the NNR Board of Directors, from nominations received from members of the public living in the relevant municipal area. The Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson will serve for a period of two years and perform their duties without financial compensation.

**Members of the public are hereby invited to submit nominations for the Chairperson of the Pelindaba Public Safety Information Forum.**

#### Please take note of the following requirements for submitting nominations:

- Only written nominations will be considered. (Hand written or typed)
- A declaration of acceptance by the nominee must accompany the written nomination.
- A copy of the nominees current CV.
- Certified copies of identity documents for the nominee and the person making the nomination.

The selection criteria includes but not limited to the following:

- Submission must comply with the requirements as advertised;
- Nominee must reside in the relevant municipal area as per regulation;
- Experience in community based initiatives; and
- Attendance of Public Safety Information Forum meetings.

National Nuclear Regulator (NNR) ke taolo e ikemetseng e thomilweng jaaka moatlhodi go ya ka Karolo 3 ya National Nuclear Regulator Act (Act No. 47 ya 1999) go laola tiriso ya maatla a nuklea go sireletsa batho, dithoto le tikologo go tswa go tshenyo ya nuklea mo Aforika Borwa.

Go ya ka National Nuclear Regulator Act, taolo ya taolo ya NNR e akaretsa dintlhakgolo tse di latelang ;

- d) baakanya tlhomamisego le tumelano ka maemo a tetelelo ya nuklea ka go tseya thulaganyo ya taelo;
- e) tiragatso ya maikaelelo a ditšhaba mo lobakeng la go tlhompha melao ya ditšhabatšhaba malebana le nuklea le tshireletso ; le
- f) go netefatsa gore paakanyetso tshoganyetso ya go loga maano a nuklea a mo boemong.
