GENERAL AUTHORISATION CONDITIONS

1. The holder shall be liable for nuclear damage which may arise from activities performed in terms of this authorisation.
2. The strategy for clean-up of the sites and the post cleanup radiological survey strategy shall be in accordance with document DEP-CTR-10/09 and the NNR Guide Document GD-1047.
3. Transportation of radioactive material or of any equipment or objects contaminated with radioactive material off the sites or on roads, which are accessible to the public must be carried out in accordance with document TRS-CTR-10/09.
4. Clean-up and removal of contaminated material to which this authorisation apply shall be conducted in accordance with document WMP-CTR.
5. All activities carried out within the scope of this authorisation shall be subject to the provisions of NNR Safety Standards and Regulatory Practices No. R388 and of the document QMP-CTR.
6. The programme for conducting activities within the scope of this authorization as set out in Section 10 of the Guide for Application of Nuclear Authorisation shall be adhered to.
7. All occurrences shall be reported to the regulator as per the procedure set out in document ONR-CTR
8. Control to prevent unauthorized access to areas containing radioactive material and to prevent the unauthorized removal of such material, shall be done as per procedure AEP-CTR and PSP-CTR-10/09.
9. The Radiation Protection Programme set out in document RPP-CRT-10/09 must be implemented to prevent worker and public exposures that may arise from activities performed in terms of this authorisation.
