



# INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS TO SERVE AS DEPUTY CHAIRPERSON OF THE KOEBERG PUBLIC SAFETY INFORMATION FORUM (PSIF)

The National Nuclear Regulator (NNR) is an independent regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Nuclear Regulator, 1999 (Act No. 47 of 1999) to regulate the use of nuclear energy and materials to protect health, safety, security and the environment from nuclear damage in South Africa.

## IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL NUCLEAR REGULATOR ACT, THE NNR'S REGULATORY MANDATE INVOLVES THE FOLLOWING PRIORITY AREAS:

- (a) provide for the protection of persons, property and the environment against nuclear damage through the establishment of safety standards and regulatory practices;
- (b) exercise regulatory control related to safety over:
  - (i) the siting, design, construction, operation, manufacture of component parts and decontamination, decommissioning and closure of nuclear installations; and
  - (ii) vessels propelled by nuclear power or having radioactive material on board, which is capable of causing nuclear damage, through the granting of nuclear authorisations.
- (c) exercise regulatory control over other actions, to which this Act applies, through the granting of nuclear authorisations;
- (d) provide assurance of compliance with the conditions of nuclear authorisations through the implementation of a system of compliance inspections;
- (e) fulfil national obligations in respect of international legal instruments concerning
- (f) nuclear safety; and
- (g) ensure that provisions for nuclear emergency planning are in place.

In accordance with Regulation 968 of 12 September 2008 the authorisation holder is responsible for the establishment of a Public Safety Information Forum (PSIF) to inform the persons living in the municipal area in respect of which an emergency plan has been established on nuclear and radiation safety information related to the nuclear installation.

The PSIF shall have a Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson who will be appointed by the NNR Board of Directors from nominations received from members of the public living in the relevant municipal area.

The Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson will serve for a period of two years and perform their duties without financial compensation. Members of the public are hereby invited to submit nominations for the Deputy Chairperson of the Koeberg Public Safety Information Forum (PSIF).

## PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMITTING NOMINATIONS:

- Only written nominations will be considered. (Handwritten or typed).
- A declaration of acceptance by the nominee must accompany the written nomination.
- A copy of the nominees current CV.
- Certified copies of Identity documents of the nominee and the person making the nomination.
