Dear Stakeholder

The NNR Board of Directors wishes to inform all stakeholders and the public that Dr. Mzubanzi Bismark Tyobeka will be resigning as the Chief Executive Officer of the National Nuclear Regulator (NNR) to pursue his profession elsewhere.

Since his appointment in September 2013, Dr Tyobeka has played a critical role in the development, growth and success of the NNR. He leaves the NNR in a very strong position for continued growth, and we sincerely thank him for his contribution and leadership. The Board would like to take this opportunity to appreciate the commitment and invaluable contribution made by Dr Tyobeka during his tenure, and wishes him all the best in his future endeavors.

Dr Tyobeka's last day at the NNR will be determined pending discussions with the Board, at which point details of an acting CEO will be announced. Until then the Board will, under the guidance and leadership of the minister, who is the appointing authority, continue to oversee the process of permanently filling the position.
