INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS TO SERVE AS DEPUTY CHAIRPERSON OF THE KOEBERG PUBLIC SAFETY INFORMATION FORUM (PSIF).

The National Nuclear Regulator (NNR) is an independent regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of Section 3 of the National Nuclear Regulator Act (Act No. 47 of 1999) to regulate the safe use of nuclear and radioactive materials in order to protect persons, property and the environment from the potential harmful effects of radiation in South Africa.

In terms of the National Nuclear Regulator Act, the NNR's regulatory mandate involves the following priority areas:

- Provide for the protection of persons, property and the environment against nuclear damage through the establishment of safety standards and regulatory practices;
- Exercise regulatory control related to safety over: (i) the siting, design, construction, operation, manufacture of component parts and decontamination, decommissioning and closure of nuclear installations; and (ii) Vessels propelled by nuclear power or having radioactive material on board, which is capable of causing nuclear damage, through the granting of nuclear authorisations.
- Exercise regulatory control over other actions, to which this Act applies, through the granting of nuclear authorisations;
- Provide assurance of compliance with the conditions of nuclear authorisations through the implementation of a system of compliance inspections;
- Fulfill national obligations in respect of international legal instruments concerning nuclear safety; and
- Ensure that provisions for nuclear emergency planning are in place.

In accordance with Licence Condition 28 of the Koeberg NIL - 01 and the provisions of Section 26(4) of the National Nuclear Regulator Act, the authorisation holder ESKOM is responsible for the establishment of a Public Safety Information Forum (PSIF) to inform the persons living in the municipal area in respect of which an emergency plan has been established on nuclear and radiation safety information related to the Koeberg nuclear power station.

A further provision in accordance with Regulation R968 of 12 September 2008, is for the PSIF to have a Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson who shall be appointed by the NNR Board of Directors, from nominations received from members of the public living in the relevant municipal area. The Chairperson and Deputy Chairperson will serve for a period of two years and perform their duties without financial compensation.

Members of the public are hereby invited to submit nominations for the Deputy Chairperson of the Koeberg Public Safety Information Forum.

Please take note of the following requirements for submitting nominations:

- Only written nominations will be considered (Hand written or typed);
- A declaration of acceptance by the nominee must accompany the written nomination;
- A copy of the nominees current CV;

Certified copies of Identity documents for the nominee and the person making the nomination; and

The selection criteria includes, but not limited to the following:

- Submission must comply with the requirements as advertised;
- Nominee must reside in the relevant municipal area as per regulation;
- Experience in community-based initiatives; and
- Attendance of Public Safety Information Forum meetings.
- Nominee must reside in the relevant municipal area as per regulation.

UITNODIGING VIR NOMINASIES OM AS ONDERVOORSITTER VAN DIE KOEBERG OPENBARE VEILIGHEIDSINLIGTINGSFORUM (PSIF) TE DIEN.

Die Nasionale Kernreguleerder (NNR) is 'n onafhanklike reguleringsowerheid wat ingevolge Artikel 3 van die Wet op die Nasionale Kernreguleerder (Wet No. 47 van 1999) as regs persoon gestig is om die veilige gebruik van kern- en radioaktiewe materiale te reguleer ten einde persone, eiendom en die omgewing teen die moontlike skadelike gevolge van bestraling in Suid-Afrika te beskerm.

Ingevolge die Wet op die Nasionale Kernreguleerder behels die NNR se regulatoriese mandaat die volgende prioriteitsareas:

- Voorziening maak vir die beskerming van persone, eiendom en die omgewing teen kernskade deur die daarstelling van veiligheidsstandaarde en regulatoriese praktyke;
- Regulatoriese beheer met betrekking tot veiligheid uitoeven oor: (i) die ligging, ontwerp, konstruksie, bedryf, vervaardiging van onderdele en ontsmetting, ontmanteling en sluiting van kerninstallasies; En
- Vaartuie wat deur kernkrag aangedryf word of radioaktiewe materiaal aan boord het, wat kernskade kan veroorsaak deur die toestaan van kernmagtigings.
- Regulatoriese beheer uitoeven oor ander aksies, waarop hierdie Wet van toepassing is, deur die toestaan van kernmagtigings;
- Versekering te gee van voldoening aan die voorwaardes van kernmagtigings deur die implementering van 'n stelsel van nakomingsinspeksies;
- Nasionale verpligtinge ten opsigte van internasionale regsinstrumente ten opsigte van kernveiligheid nakom; En
- Te verseker dat voorsiening vir kernnoodbeplanning in plek is.

Ingevolge lisensievoorwaarde 28 van die Koeberg NIL - 01 en die bepalinge van Artikel 26(4) van die Wet op die Nasionale Kernreguleerder, is die magtigingshouer ESKOM verantwoordelik vir die stigting van 'n Openbare Veiligheidsinligtingsforum (PSIF) om die persone wat in die munisipale gebied woon, in kennis te stel ten opsigte waarvan 'n noodplan opgestel is oor kern- en bestralingsveiligheidsinligting wat met die Koeberg-kernkragstasie verband hou.

'n Verdere bepaling ooreenkomstig Regulasie R968 van 12 September 2008 is dat die PSIF 'n Voorsitter en Ondervoorsitter moet hê wat deur die NNR Raad van Direkteure aangestel sal word, uit nominasies ontvang van lede van die publiek wat in die betrokke munisipale gebied woon.

Lede van die publiek word hiermee uitgenooi om nominasies vir die ondervoorsitter van die Koeberg-inligtingsforum vir openbare veiligheid in te dien.

Neem asseblief kennis van die volgende vereistes vir die indiening van nominasies:

- Slegs skriftelike nominasies sal oorweeg word (Met die hand geskryf of getik);
- 'n Verklaring van aanvaarding deur die genomineerde moet die skriftelike nominasie vergesel;
- 'n Afskrif van die genomineerde se huidige CV;

Gesertifiseerde afskrifte van identiteitsdokumente vir die genomineerde en die persoon wat die nominasie maak; En

Die keuringskriteria sluit in, maar nie beperk nie tot die volgende:
